Bonding agent for floor toppings, render and repair mixes for worn, damaged, spoiled and cracked concrete, beams, columns and masonry.

- 1. Ensure surfaces are sound, clean, dry and free from grease, oil, paint, laitence and loose materials.
- 2. Key surface by scabbling, grit blasting or planing.
- 3. If steel reinforcement is exposed on concrete, wire brush to remove rust and scale. Prime exposed steel with a bonding slurry and allow to dry.
- 4. Dampen porous surfaces thoroughly with water.
- 5. Prepare the bonding coat consisting of 2 parts
 Ordinary Portland Cement slurried with 1 part
 Sealotak SBR by volume and work vigorously into
 the surface with a stiff brush.
- Screed or render must be applied while the bonding coat is still wet.
- 7. Sands used must be well graded, clean and meet the appropriate British Standards. Aggregates must be dust free.

As an admixture for screeds, renders and for fixing brickslips, coping and tiles.

 Use at the rate of 5-10 litres Sealotak SBR to 25kg Cement. Due to the plasticising action of Sealotak SBR care should be taken when adding mixing water to keep workability correct.
